Responsibilities include: final inspection of all product, identification and response to nonconforming product, understanding product signs that indicate quality problems, communicating issues – present or emerging – to Manager, operate computer supported measurement equipment such as SmartScopes, participate in design and prototype meetings as appropriate, communicate clearly with design engineers regarding implications related to new parts/design changes quality system audit support, conduct receiving inspections of certified materials and outside vendor supplied parts, and other related duties.
