Emily Wilson has more than 38 years of Quality Assurance/Quality Control experience, the majority of which have been with the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) or its national laboratories. In her current role as a Senior Quality Engineer at Pacific Northwest National Laboratory (PNNL), she supports multiple directorates including National Security, Energy and Environment, and Operational Systems.
